GHG Compliance – Reality vs. Fiction

Many facilities have assumed that they are exempt from greenhouse gas (GHG) requirements because they are not a big utility or cement kiln. Sorry, but that assumption is frequently incorrect. Come to our free class and learn about reality versus fiction for GHG compliance and how it pertains to your facility.

- Under California's AB 32, general stationary combustion sources that generate over 25,000 metric tons of CO₂ are required to report their emissions to the Air Resources Board (ARB). Facilities that may be captured include: colleges & universities, food and mineral processing, oil production, steel foundries, industrial gases, natural gas transmission, malt beverages and paperboard manufacturing. In addition, small cogeneration facilities that emit more than 2,500 MT CO₂ or have a nameplate capacity >1 MW are required to report.
- California has identified seventy-three (73) command-and-control rules which cover diverse processes and equipment which emit GHGs. These rules are independent from the mandatory reporting thresholds and requirements. Do you know which command-and-control rules pertain to your operations?
- EPA is planning to finalize its rule for mandatory reporting of GHGs this Fall. Facilities will need to start collecting GHG data on January 1, 2010 and submit their first report by 3-31-2011. EPA has identified 40 discrete industrial sectors and 13,205 facilities that must report. Are you one of them?
